PACKING

Load your pack so the most used items are closest to the opening. Arrange your items so the pack is as flat as possible.

PACK PADS

Use the Pack Pads to line the inside of the pack to cushion your back and protect your gear and pack.

TUCK & ROLL CLOSURE

Leaving at least the top 4 inches empty, tuck the top edge of the material under the flap. Squeeze the air out, by pulling the closure down. Roll the black strap down over itself at least three times. Bend the buckles around, toward the rolls, and clip them together. (Fig. 1)

QUICK STRAP

For the strongest, most versatile system - find the middle of the strap and push a few inches through the grommet. Hook a carabiner in the loop. Hook the side carabiners into one of the holes along the side of the pack and attach the strap to the carabiner. You can adjust the length of the straps by moving the carabiner into a different position on the pack or strap. (Fig. 2)

WEARING

Wear it "upside down." Wear it on your back so the opening is at the bottom and the grommet at the top. For best result, wear the buckle and top carabiner against your back. Make sure the straps are even. (Fig. 3)

DRAGGING or HANGING

Activate the Quick Strap by pulling the top carabiner away from the pack so that the strap is pulled through the grommet. Connect carabiner to desired attachment point for hanging or dragging. You can also reconfigure the straps to make them several different lengths. (Fig. 4)

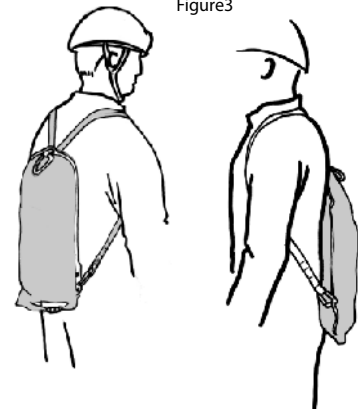
